Tanzania

Tanzania is surely one of the world's great safari destinations. Blessed with abundant and varied wildlife, hundreds of bird species and a plethora of stunning landscapes, Tanzania is a mecca for those seeking a real African experience. Here, you will find the unforgettable Mount Kilimanjaro, the world's tallest free-standing mountain, the timeless Serengeti, its acacia-dotted plains evoking images of the classic safari experience, and Zanzibar, whose perfectly white beaches and turquoise seas are like something from a dream. Tanzania is also home to the colorful Maasai people, who for many represent Africa itself, and to one of Africa's last functioning hunter-gathered tribes, the Hadzabe. This means that the natural richness of the country is complemented by a cultural one. Visitors will find Tanzania a welcoming, safe, and fascinating place to spend time.

Pemba

Unlike the low-lying coral atoll of neighbouring Zanzibar, Pemba is a true island with incredibly fertile hilly terrain and spectacular deepwater drop-offs for divers. Despite its proximity Pemba really is off the beaten track, getting less than 1% of its neighbour's visitor traffic. Those who do venture here are rewarded with an authentic Swahili Coast experience. There are more natural forests and plantations than on Zanzibar Island, and Pemba grows more cloves than her bigger sister.

Pemba offers today's visitor a number of attractions including lovely beaches, world-class scuba diving and a number of historical sites. Ngezi Forest Reserve is a beautiful place to visit, as is Misali Island, which Captain Kidd is reputed to have used as a hide-out in the 17th century.

Excursion Ngezi Rainforest Tour : The Ngezi Forest is a protected forest reserve and is home to a variety of endemic bird species, the Pemba sunbirds, green pigeon, and Scops owl to name a few. It is also home to vervet and black colobus monkeys.

Excursion Spice Tour : There is no doubt that Pemba is a spice island once you have visited the spice farm. A fascinating experience as the owner shows you around his farm and informs you of all the secrets that these spices hold. 70 % of the world's clove harvest comes out of Pemba Island. This excursion takes approximately 2 hours.

Then, spend the afternoon relaxing on the beach or at the pool, and enjoy a massage at Manta's spa.

Excursion scuba diving : Swim amongst some of the most stunning sea life in the world with PADI-certified dive instructors! Pemba offers quintessential Indian Ocean diving, with coral-choked walls, colorful reefs, big bommies and enormous sea fans orbited by an amazing cast of reef fish. The diving here tends to be more advanced, with depths in the 30-40 metre/100-130 foot range. This remote Coral Sea atoll is made up of several individual sites. But, North Horn is perhaps its most famous for its shark feed. Most of the diners are whitetips, grey whalers, silvertips and the occasional hammerhead, but you'll also see potato cod, bigeye trevally and bumphead parrotfish.

You'll still have time to relax at the resort in the afternoon.
